The union and the company continued discussions this week in Montréal with the assistance of the conciliator.

The only issues remaining on the table are Job Security, duration of the collective agreement and wages.

As reported in an earlier bulletin, the conciliator's mandate will end on November 15<sup>th</sup>. At that time his report will have been filed to the Minister of Labour. That being said, we will reconvene in Montreal next week in an effort to obtain a settlement with the assistance of the conciliator.

As a result of one member of the bargaining committee leaving next week, we have been joined by the elected alternate from the Ontario region in accordance with our bargaining rules.
