

In November 2002, the **DON HOLDER SCHOLARSHIP** was created in memory of CEP's founding President, DON HOLDER. Part of Don's vision for the new union was a strong National Education Program.

He brought together an Education Committee to develop our first CEP Education Courses. The Program has expanded over the years and now includes a host of different courses covering topics such as grievance handling, negotiations, organizing, workplace change, anti-harassment and resistance to corporate globalization.

In recognition of Don Holder's commitment to union education, sixteen (16) scholarships are awarded each year to CEP members so they can attend CEP courses. Up to \$1,000 is given to each of four CEP members in each region to assist in covering expenses such as lost wages, per diem, travel and hotel.

Each region selects four CEP members to receive the scholarship to attend CEP courses. In any year the National Executive Board may decide promote the participation of a specific group, such as young workers, by giving them priority to receive the scholarships.

CEP Locals can apply for the scholarship by completing the attached form and submitting the name of a deserving candidate from the local and forward it to the CEP Region Office of your region.

A maximum of four scholarships will be awarded per region per year, normally two in the spring and two in the fall. Preference may be given to locals who may not otherwise have the financial resources to participate in CEP courses or in circumstances where we need to promote participation in specific courses. **Please complete the attached form and submit to the appropriate Regional Office.**

DON HOLDER SCHOLARSHIP

- The Don Holder Scholarships has been created in memory of the founding President of CEP, Don Holder. Part of Don's vision for the new union was a strong National Education Program. He brought together an Education Committee to develop our first CEP Education Courses. The program has expanded over the years and now includes a dozen different courses covering topics such as grievance handling, negotiations, organizing, workplace change, anti-harassment and resistance to corporate globalization.
- In recognition of Don Holder's commitment to union education, sixteen (16) scholarships will be awarded each year to CEP members so they can attend CEP courses. Up to \$1,000 will be given to each of four CEP members in each region to assist in covering expenses such as lost wages, per diem, travel and hotel.
- Each region will select four CEP members to receive the scholarship to attend CEP courses. In any year the National Executive Board may decide to promote the participation of a specific group, such as young people, by giving them priority to receive the scholarships.
- The National Union will produce a leaflet that honours Brother Holder's memory, provides details of the scholarships and includes a form for Local Unions to submit names of candidates. The regions will use the leaflet to advertise the scholarship when they send course information to Locals.
- The recipients of the scholarship will receive a certificate at the end of the course signifying that they have successfully complete the course.
- Each fall the National Union will produce a booklet to highlight members who received scholarships and promote participation in CEP courses. This booklet will be sent to all Local Unions.
